## Regular Meeting Minutes Salem Electric Board of Directors 20 December 2023 6:00 p.m.

- 1. <u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: The Salem Electric Board of Directors meeting was called to order by President Anderson. Directors present: Jeff Anderson, Jan Bargen, Dave Bauer, Tim Klarr, Joe Van Meter, and Angie Villery. Staff members present: Tony Schacher, General Manager; Jacob Knudsen, Member Services Manager; Chris Krieck, Administrative Services Manager; and Randi Johnson, Executive Assistant. (A list of the members, employees, and guests in attendance is in the Supplemental Minutes Book.)
- 2. <u>EXECUTIVE SESSION</u>: The Board immediately convened in executive session to discuss the upcoming audit with Scott Daniels of Aldrich CPAs & Advisors LLP. At 6:50 p.m., the Board reconvened the regular meeting.
- 3. APPEARANCE OF INTERESTED MEMBERS: None.
- 4. <u>MEETING AGENDA</u>: **MOTION** made by Bargen, seconded by Van Meter, and **carried unanimously** to approve the Meeting Agenda.
- 5. <u>CONSENT CALENDAR</u>: **MOTION** made by Bauer, seconded by Van Meter, and **carried unanimously** to approve the Consent Calendar with the removal of Item D Financial Report, Item E Engineering and Operations Report, and Item F Member Services Report.
- 6. <u>CONSIDERATION OF ITEMS REMOVED FROM THE CONSENT CALENDAR</u>: Item D: Questions regarded office and plant employee wages. Item E: Questions regarded the interruptions report. Item F: Questions regarded costs associated with delinquent accounts. **MOTION** made by Klarr, seconded by Bargen, and **carried unanimously** to approve Items D, E, and F.

## 7. <u>ACTION/INFORMATION ITEMS</u>:

<u>Forfeiture of Unclaimed Capital Credits – Action</u>: **MOTION** made by Van Meter, seconded by Bauer, and **carried unanimously** to approve Capital Retains Resolution No. 12-20-23 as presented. (A copy of the resolution is in the Supplemental Minutes book.)

Salem Electric Member Assistance Program (SEMAP) Year-End Report – Information: Sara Lute, member resources specialist, reviewed the program and noted that during 2023, Salem Electric provided \$199,850 to 1,142 members who qualified for assistance with their electricity bills and stated that funds were depleted in July. The program will be able to assist more members in 2024 due to an increase in funding. To date, Salem Electric has received approximately 300 applications for the 2024 program.

<u>Annual Agenda Items Calendar – Information</u>: The Board reviewed and discussed the Agenda Items Calendar, which is a list of topics addressed by the Board on an annual cycle. **MOTION** made by Van Meter, and seconded by Bauer, and **carried unanimously** to add biannual safety reports to the calendar.

## 8. MONTHLY REPORTS:

<u>Department Updates</u>: Administrative Services—Krieck informed the Board of a personnel update. Member Services—Knudsen reviewed the billing cycle timeline and discussed changes to disconnect notices.

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Manager's Report: Schacher reported that a settlement between the U.S. Government and the states of Oregon and Washington, Nez Perce Tribe, Confederated Tribes and Bands of the Yakama Nation, Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation, and the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation (the Six Sovereigns), which regards the Columbia River System Operations, was filed in U.S. District Court on December 14. Public power entities and other river-user stakeholders were excluded from the settlement negotiations and have until December 29, 2023, to respond. The Board had significant discussions about the potential impact of the agreement.

Schacher highlighted December employee service anniversaries.

Outside Meeting Reports: None.
