

Easy Pay Options

Online Bill Pay: For those wanting flexibility at your fingertips, log on to **SalemElectric.com**, click on SmartHub® and set up your account for online bill pay.

AutoPay: Complete an AutoPay authorization form or sign up online at **SalemElectric.com**. An automatic payment is made on the due date.

Average Pay Plan: Make budgeting easier by having your monthly bills averaged over the past 12 months and pay a similar amount each month.

Heating Bill Assistance Program: Members who meet income guidelines can receive a credit on their account.

- Household must use electricity as its main heat source and household income cannot exceed 60% of Oregon's median income
- Seniors and persons with disabilities apply beginning December; all others apply in January
- Credits are applied one time per heating season
- Program ends April 30, or when program funds are expended, whichever comes first

Dollar Check-Off Program: Administered by The Salvation Army and funded through member donations.

- Funds available year-round for qualified members
- Contact our office for information on additional assistance resources

Habitat Improvement Program

Voluntary opportunity for members to help improve local native fish and wildlife habitat.

- Make a one-time donation or sign up to have a monthly donation added to your electric bill
- Voluntary contributions support efforts to improve local fish and wildlife habitat
- Donations from members in Polk County assist Glenn-Gibson Creek projects; donations from Marion County members benefit Claggett Creek projects.

Appliance Program: Residential members who purchase qualifying appliances receive a credit on their Salem Electric account.

- Eligible appliances include refrigerators, freezers, water heaters and clothes washers
- A list of participating dealers is available (you are not limited to these dealers)
- To receive your credit, participants must complete a rebate claim form attaching a copy of their receipt and the yellow Energy Guide label

Appliance Recycling: Residential members who recycle their operable refrigerator or freezer (must be 10 cubic feet or larger) receive a credit on their Salem Electric account.

Heat Pump Program: Incentives available for residential members who install high-efficiency ductless or air source heat pumps.

- Projects must be pre-approved and all installations are inspected by Salem Electric
- Residences must meet minimum insulation standards
- Installers must be selected from Salem Electric's approved contractor list
- Heat pumps must meet efficiency requirements

WeatherWise: Residential weatherization for your home or rental property with a portion of the cost paid by Salem Electric.

- Must have permanently-installed electric heat as your only heat source (excluding wood heat or heat pumps with a gas back-up system)
- Free energy audit by a Salem Electric energy expert identifies eligible weatherization measures
- Projects must be pre-approved and all installations are inspected by Salem Electric
- Incentives paid toward the cost of insulation and glass improvements
- Installers must be selected from Salem Electric's approved contractor list

Efficient Light Bulbs: Members can purchase Energy Star-rated screw-in compact fluorescent or LED bulbs at cost in Salem Electric's Member Services Department. These bulbs use less energy, produce less heat and last longer than incandescent bulbs with comparable light output.

Efficient Lighting Fixtures: Members who install new hard-wired, Energy Star-rated fluorescent or LED fixtures can receive a credit on their Salem Electric account for each qualifying fixture purchased (credit not to exceed 50% of the total fixture cost).

Area Lighting: Salem Electric staff can visit your home or business to determine the type of fixture that best meets your needs. Fixtures are pole-mounted, photocell controlled and maintained by Salem Electric; the monthly energy charge is included on your electric bill.

Heat Pump Water Heater: Incentives for members with an existing electric water heater who install a heat pump water heating system.

Solar Water Heating System: Incentives available for members with an existing electric water heater who install a solar water heating system.

High-Performance Shower Heads: Free high-performance shower heads and faucet aerators installed by Salem Electric staff for all members with electric water heaters.

Photovoltaic (PV) Program: Incentives available to members who install a photovoltaic system.

- Systems must be member-owned and meet Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE) requirements and Salem Electric's net metering requirements
- Installer must be ODOE-certified

Energy Smart Design: Incentives for commercial and industrial members who install energy efficient measures (lighting, motors, building shell improvements, HVAC, etc.).

- Salem Electric staff provides an energy audit to identify energy saving recommendations and inspects all installations
- Rebates available for eligible measures on new or existing buildings
